

THE CITY OF BRONWOOD 2021 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Bronwood is considering applying to the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) of up to \$750,000. These funds must be used to primarily benefit low and moderate-income persons.

The City is specifically interested in applying for CDBG funds to make street and storm drainage improvements in a targeted area in the County. The Southwest Georgia Regional Commission is the Grant Writer and Administrator.

The activities for which these funds may be used are in the areas of housing, public facilities, and economic development. More specific details regarding eligible activities, plans to assist displaced person (if any), the estimated amount of funds proposed to be used for the activities to benefit low- and moderate-income persons and the rating system will be provided at a public hearing will be held at the City of Bronwood's City Hall, located at 102 West Main Street, Bronwood, Georgia 39826, on May 4, 2021 at 11:30 AM.

The purpose of this hearing will be to obtain citizen input into the development of the CDBG application and to review progress on the previous CDBG grant (if applicable).
